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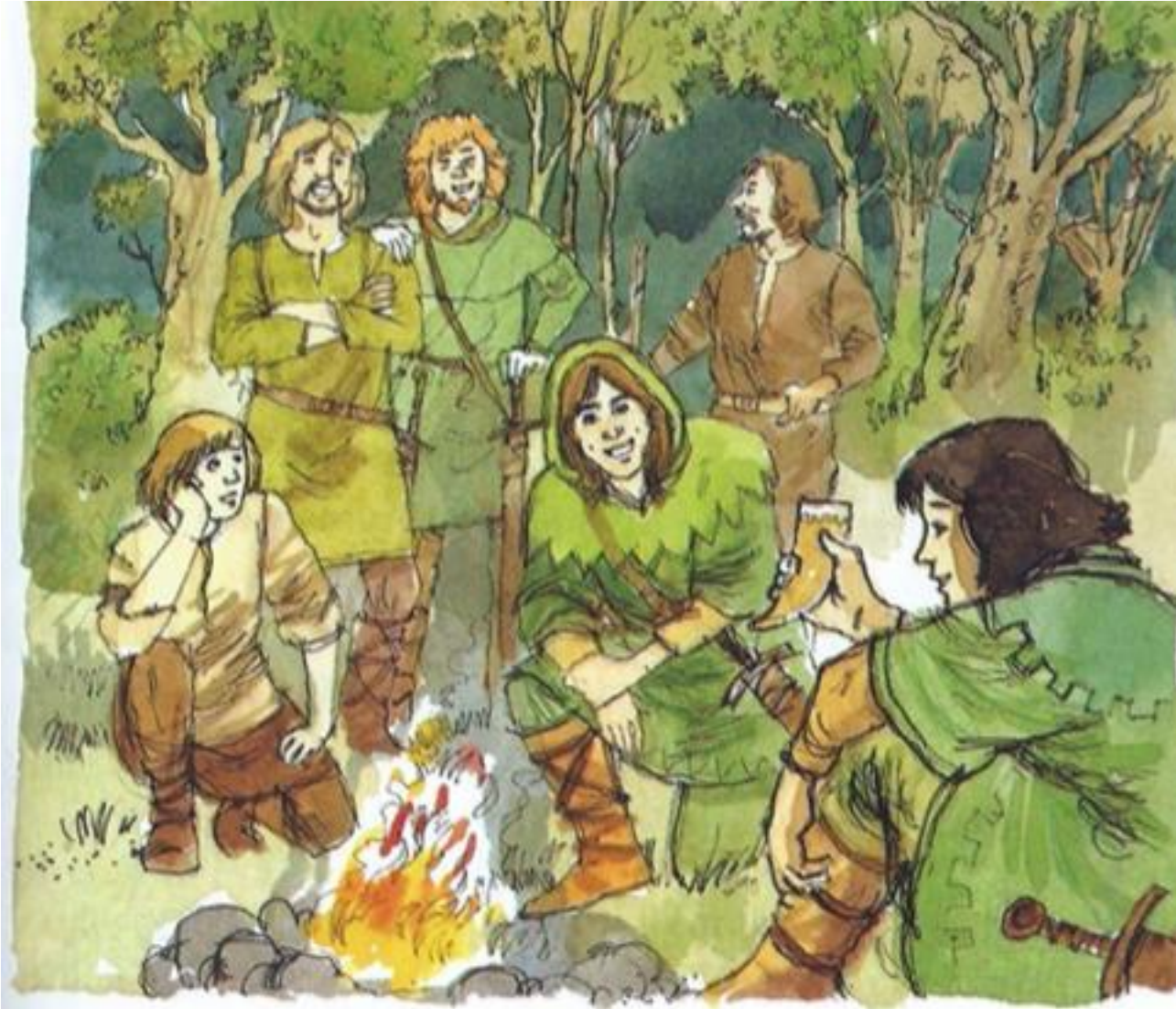
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CHAPTER 3

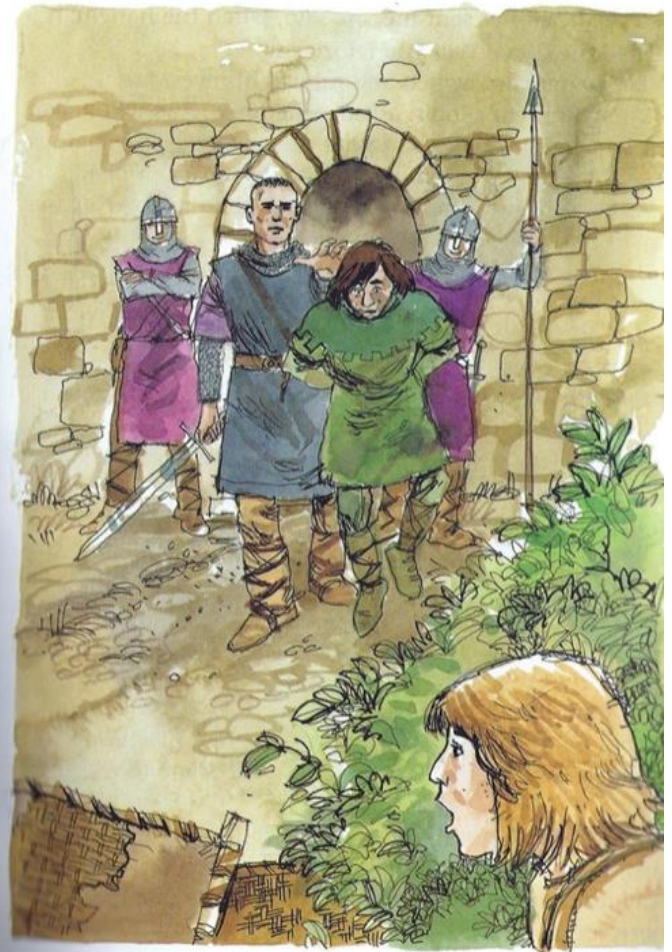
'And then Sir Guy's men took Will away! There was nothing I could do to help him, Robin ...'

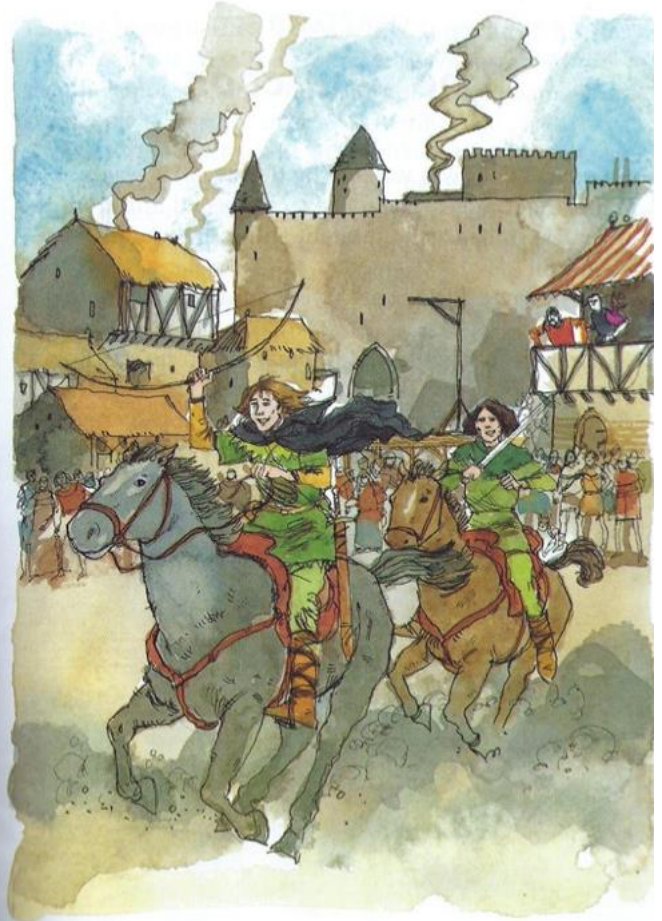
Robin quickly pulled his hood down over his face and walked up to the Sheriff.
