GRAMMAR- PRESENT PERFECT

WE USE THE PRESENT PERFECT TO TALK ABOUT AN ACTION THAT STARTED IN THE PAST AND CONTINUES IN THE PRESENT, OR OUR EXPERIENCES UP TO THE PRESENT MOMENT: WE OFTEN USE THE ADVERB EVER (NEVER IN NEGATIVE) WHEN WE USE THE PRESENT PERFECT.

WE CAN'T USE THE PRESENT PERFECT WITH SPECIFIC TIME EXPRESSIONS:

EXAMPLE: YESTERDAY, WHEN I WAS A CHILD.

WE FORM THE PRESENT PERFECT WITH THE PRESENT TENSE OF **HAVE+PAST PARTICIPLE OF A VERB.**

EXAMPLE:

HAVE YOUR FAMILY **EVER BEEN** TO CAÑO CRISTALES?

YES, WE **HAVE BEEN** THERE. YES, **WE `VE BEEN** THERE.

NO, WE **HAVE NEVER BEEN** THERE. NO, **WE `VE NEVER BEEN** THERE.

- 1. Caño Cristales River:** Also called the *River of Colours*. This spectacular natural wonder is located in Serranía de la Macarena; Department of Meta.


