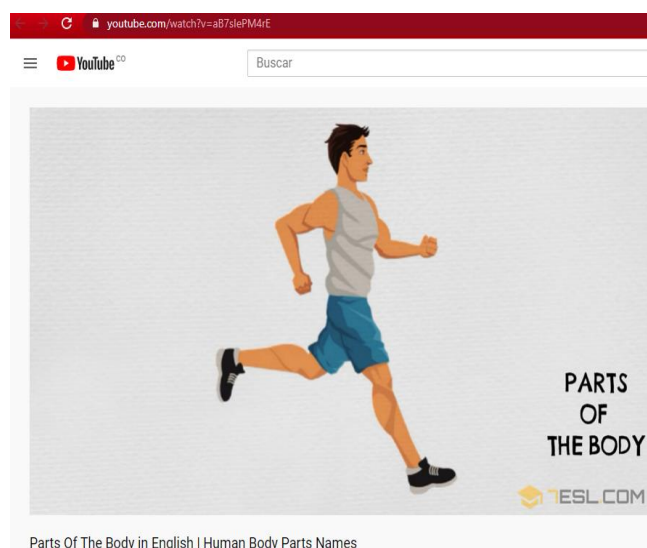

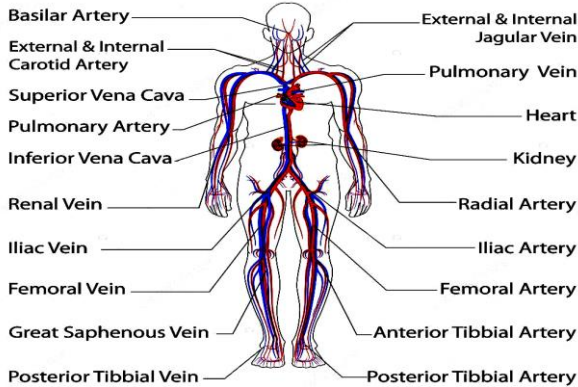


THE HUMAN BODY - ILLNESSES AND DISEASES

CHART 1

HUMAN BODY: The body uses different **systems** to work properly. Some of these are:

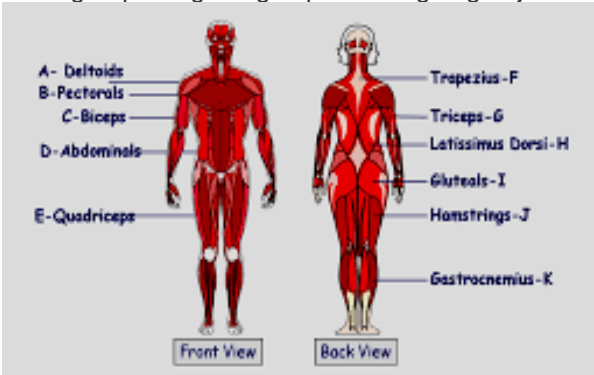
1. Circulatory system: how our blood moves around



2. Skeletal system: another term for the bones in our body, which together make up our skeleton



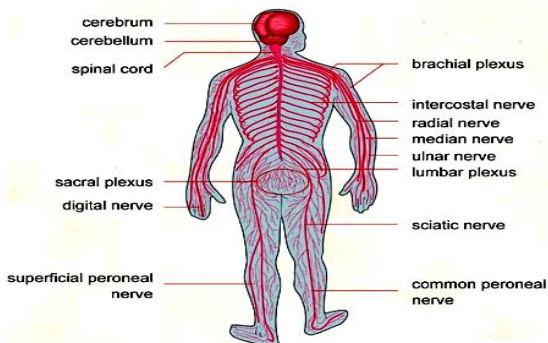
3. Muscular system: how we move around; our muscles allow us to do everything from walking and running to picking things up and laughing at jokes!



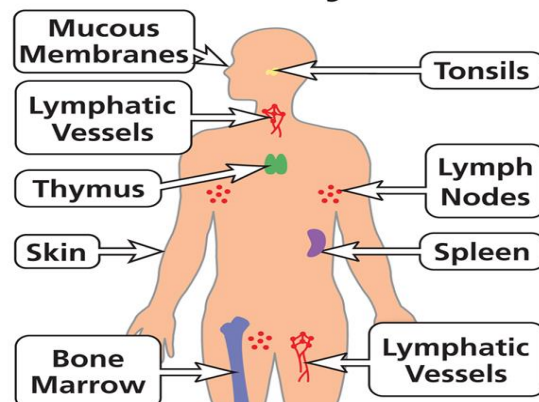
4. Digestive system: how the food we eat turns into nutrients, fats and waste through our stomach and intestines



5. Nervous system: how messages get sent around our body, through our brain, so we know when we're hungry, when something hurts, when something smells good and when something feels soft.



6. Immune system: a network of cells, tissues, and organs that work together to fight off sickness and protect the body.
